PROPOSED ORDER

This matter having been opened to the Court by motion of the government dated November 15, 2006 (Docket No. 9) seeking an award pursuant to the Act To Prevent Pollution From Ships ("APPS"), Title 33 United States Code Sections 1901 et seq.; and

The Court having considered the government's motion; and

No response having been filed by defendant Sun Ace Shipping Company; and

Defendant Sun Ace Shipping Company having pleaded guilty on September 6, 2006, to a one-count Information charging a violation of Title 33, United States Code, Section 1908(a); and

Defendant Sun Ace Shipping Company having been sentenced on November 13, 2006, to pay a fine in the amount of \$400,000 pursuant to the Act to Prevent Pollution From Ships,

IT IS hereby ORDERED as follows:

1. The government's motion is GRANTED.
2. Pursuant to Title 33, United States Code, Section 1908(a), a total of \$200,000.00 is awarded to the following persons in the following amounts:

3. Each amount is to be paid by the Clerk of Court from the fine paid by defendant Sun Ace Shipping Company. Upon receipt of the fine payment from defendant Sun Ace Shipping Company, the Clerk of Court shall mail checks to the persons specified above, payable to those persons, and in the amounts specified above.
